

Action Taken Report on Feedback

The issues and suggestions received from various stakeholders and the action taken by the institute regarding these issues is given below:

Feedback from Students		
1.	More focus should be on practical life situations and skill development	The syllabi are revised regularly by the departments in BoS meetings to focus on employability and skill development. Skill enhancement courses (SECs) are essential part of many programmes. Short term certificate courses focussing on skill development are also offered by the college. In addition, activities focussed on skill development such as workshops, training sessions, were planned and carried out by departments.
2.	Student counselling should be provided by the college	The students have been assigned mentors with whom they can discuss their problems. Also, Counselling cell has been established by the college where students can receive counselling support.
3.	There must be more extra-curricular activities and students must be encouraged to participate in cultural activities.	The college organised talent hunts to recognise hidden talents of students. The students are provided opportunity to participate in activities/events held in youth festivals. Training workshops of students in dramatics,

		dances, fine arts are also conducted by specialised coaches. The college students won overall trophy in the interzonal and zonal youth festival. Students are allowed duty-leave to participate and prepare for these activities.
4.	Organise visits to industries	Many departments including biotechnology, food technology, zoology organised visits to industrial units to provide real world exposure to the students.
5.	Use more ICT in teaching learning process	Majority of the classrooms are equipped with LCD projectors/smart boards. More smart boards were installed for use by the faculty, and the faculty was motivated towards integrating ICT in the teaching-learning process.
6.	Provide better lab equipment, books in library	As per the demand and requirement received from the departments, books were purchased for the library and equipment were repaired, calibrated or purchased

1.	Provide more smart boards for classrooms	More smart boards were installed
2.	No. of books of subject specialization should be increased in library	Demand from departments is taken for procuring books in the library
3.	More FDPs or faculty training programs shall be organised	Faculty is given duty leave to participate in FDPs organised by HRD centres or other institutes.

1.	Provide career guidance	The career Guidance cell of the college regularly organises training activities, organises placement drives and also shares information about various job openings with the students.
2.	Value Education should be imparted to the students	Value education is embedded in the Curriculum of various programmes and activities/events etc. are regularly held through Mata Gujri Study Circle and Department of Religion to impart value education to students

1.	Practical training, internships should be provided	Practicals/Internships/student projects are provided to the students as part of the curriculum in many programs. Also several practical training activities were organised under the DBT 'Star College Scheme'

There should be training for the Competitive exams	The Career Guidance Cell of the college organised guest lectures and interaction sessions with IAS officers to guide students about various competitive examinations. Also, the college library has a good collection of books, magazines, newspaper to help students prepare for competitive examinations.
