A meeting of the IQAC was called by the Chairman Dr Kashmir Singh on 18-10-2019 to discuss the progress report of the plan of Action 2019-20. The IQAC members discussed the plan that has been executed and accomplished by the end of the odd semester. The members also enumerated the plans that need to be realized in the coming semester. The Chairman also informed the IQAC of the submission of AQAR (2018-19).

Agenda-I: To review the plan of Action chalked out in the last meeting held on 02 July 2019.

Proceeding: The IQAC team members reviewed the progress of the plan of action chalked out in the last meeting under the guidance of the. Following observations were recorded.

CRITERION I: CURRICULUM ASPECTS

- 1. BoS meetings schedule has been shared by Dean Academics with all the departments. 
